On Monday I'll go to Aldo Moro Primary School, which is placed in Orsago Soprio, a village in Lombardia, about 40 km from Milan.


Monday 20th May

Today I went to school!


It was my first day in

immediately fond of me!




They all wanted to hug me

Tuesday 21st May



The first place we visited was Murano island, which is famous for glass blowing. It was amazing to see the glass-makers in their furnace...




Then we visited Burano, which is famous for its lace and its coloured houses.


There we visited a dressmaker lab where we saw how they produce the typical Carnival masks. It was an awesome experience...



This morning we had a wonderful time because we had two Skype calls. The first one was with Greece and the second one with Slovakia.


The 4th graders told their partner schools about the main

Smiled.



When the kids rushed in,

the bus...





The biggest one was BESANOSAURUS, the meat-eater...




After that, we could make lovely crafts with paper and fabrics to reproduce the natural environment of the fossils who lived millions of years ago.

There's excitement in the air because the kids are practising for the welcome show of Tuesday 19TH...


We are all looking forward to show our Erasmus partners how good we are at singing and dancing!




19TH NOVEMBER

and had great fun!





20th November


Today we began the job shadowing, the TPM meetings and the Erasmus teachers talked about their countries, traditions and heroes.

In the afternoon, we went to Varese and climbed up the Sacred Mount.




Lidia and Luca explained us the historical and cultural features of this UNESCO site. Its 14 chapels with terracotta statues depict the most important events in the life of Christ.
